



Vitro Architectural Glass: Statement on the Build America, Buy America Act

Vitro Architectural Glass is a United States company with its principal place of business in Cheswick, Pennsylvania, and is in the business of designing, engineering, and manufacturing float and Solarban® & Sungate® coated float glass for architectural glass products.

The Build America, Buy America Act (“BABA”) requires that construction materials for certain federally funded infrastructure projects be “produced in the United States” and “that all manufacturing processes for the construction material occurred in the United States.” BABA also requires that manufactured products for certain federally funded infrastructure projects be manufactured in the United States and “the cost of the components of the manufactured product that are mined, produced, or manufactured in the United States is greater than 55% of the total cost of all components of the manufactured product.”

The glass produced at Vitro’s United States facilities qualify as “construction materials” for purposes of BABA. When Vitro glass is used to create a “manufactured product,” this domestically sourced glass can help achieve the 55% cost threshold because the entire cost of the glass can be attributed to this threshold.

Customers that require glass produced in Vitro’s United States Facilities in order to comply with BABA should contact their Vitro Sales Representative to ensure that the required glass can be certified in advance of any supply deadlines. If a completed and/or in progress project requires certification that any Vitro glass utilized complies with BABA, please inquire with your Vitro Sales Representative to verify that the glass was produced at one of Vitro’s United States facilities.
